

- Greeting by Chair Glynda Duncan...keeping with timeline, met twice last semester, sent out survey, online survey, 298 responded online from constituents, today we will review data and summarize overview, we will meet again in March, this team will do research to narrow a topic,
- Group Introductions
- Margaret Dixon, explained QEP acronym and meaning, this group came out the first group for the second QEP, All of SACSCOC standards changed, should not spend a lot of money on the QEP, we will use institutional data...report card, annual review, course completion rates, etc.
- M.D. The next meeting will be a data meeting, narrow down to three topics, team will research to narrow down topics, ATD will help the institution revamp its focus for student success, ATD will send their own team to help us, we need to have a topic ready, help students get to the finish line. \$750000 investment for the next four years and it is a must that we do what they ask of us, will use their help to write the QEP, institutional team reports to ATD meeting in Nashville this February and kickoff in June 2018, ICAT from ATD Institutional Capacity

SACSCOC comes in Sept 2020, then conduct a pilot even before SACSCOC comes, 566 responded to the first survey, students commented about a lot of topics, 70 comments that are applicable to QEP purpose, QEP Survey Results handout, CCC Surveys handouts, the goal is to have enough data to share with ATD when they come in,

- Homework: Strategic Plan, Report Card, Budget, Program Reviews, and Annual Reports, Mrs. Dixon is going to compile data from the these reports by the March 9<sup>th</sup> meeting for student learning outcomes and success and faculty driven, especially look at the report card based on first time full time cohort, annual reports are not posted yet because we are in the first year of completing that process, the budget is on the MCCB website,
- Members of the team...this is your opportunity to make suggestions if you know something needs to be done, student centered, everything has to be measured/assessed, start a pilot Sept 2019,
- M.D. A cohort is needed for the QEP emphasis...first time full time student roughly 495-600 students to focus on for new QEP to make it to the finish line in 2-3 years or 100-150%... a cohort is a student who enters college the first time full time
