Minutes from the QEP (April 25, 2019) meeting

The Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) committee met in Whiteside Hall, Room 204 at 2:00 p.m.

Mr. Tony Brooks facilitated the meeting. Mr. Brooks is still waiting on some updates to finalize the advising manual before sending it to Dr. Brown. Mr. Brooks also stated that the ATD team recommended a placement test for students 21 and over once it is approved. He also mentioned there should be a clear definition of what orientation is. It was suggested that orientation should be taken within the first 20 hours of a student's program/major. It was suggested that orientation class would be an 8-week class and also have some life skills in it. There are some 8-week course orientation classes already in place. There was a discrepancy about the course number for orientation. It should be looked at as well.
